The community of Las
Nubes is nested in the
misty forest on a mountain
not far from Xela AID's
base of operations. A
handful of children from
the exceptionally isolated
community participate in
Xela AID's Work-Study
Scholarship Program. For
many years, a small
structure made of wood

served as a classroom for just a handful of children, with many others unable to study. In recent years, Xela AID helped to add several classrooms, including the one pictured where construction was completed recently. Improvements at Las Nubes are being made possible through the generosity of volunteer **Sherry Robin**, who is also overseeing Xela AID's Literacy Program.
